

## A) Buda, the jewel of the city

February 6th / February 11th

Buda is the older, residential and hilly part of the capital. Walking among the numerous monuments and historical memories guests have the opportunity to discover the special, exciting experiences Buda provides to its visitors..

We start our tour on the Citadell, from where we can enjoy the spectacular view to the entire City.

Our next stop is the Castle District, where we walk along the small narrow streets discovering the historical part of Budapest

- The Fishermen's Bastion, a small fortress from the turn of the century, offering a beautiful view to Pest
- The Matthias Church with its colorful ceramic roof has become one of the symbols of the capital
- The Royal Palace of Buda which houses today the National Széchenyi Library and a complex of museums, including the Hungarian National Gallery.

Hot wine on the Ellipse Terrace:

Guest will be greeted by a glass of hot wine and fresh warm pogácsa (typical salted pastry) on the Ellipse terrace &ndash; from here you can really enjoy the fantastic panorama to the pest part , especially the Danube & Chain Bridge
